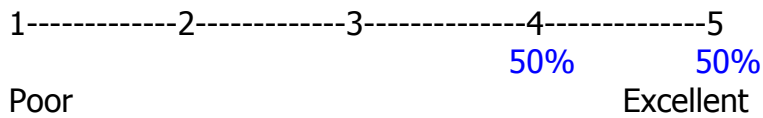

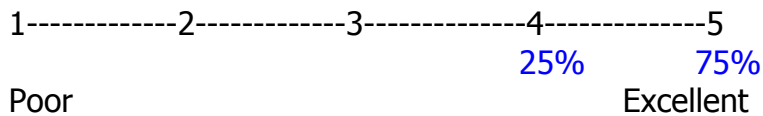
Your child has participated in *the **KIDZ Have Rights*** training program, developed by the Body Safety Steering Committee of Kent County and you observed this presentation.

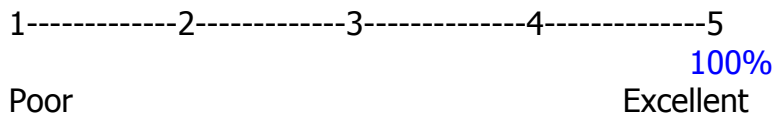
